- It is the responsibility of the owner for each boat they have berthed at WSRBC to have a valid licence for use on the River Thames and for Weybridge Sailing and Recreational Boating Club events and/or other relevant waterways.
- Members must read and abide by the rules and policies of the club.
- Members must agree and abide by the safeguarding measures in place at the club including reading the club's safeguarding; anti-bullying; dogs on premises (if applicable); accessibility policy; and handbook before membership can commence.
